POLICIES

The Hall Trustees are committed to providing a facility that meets the needs of Hall Users, and to abiding by the following policies.

Hall Users will comply with all conditions and regulations made in respect of the premises by the Fire Authority, Local Authority, Local Magistrates Court, Phonographic Performance Ltd, the Formal Conditions of Hire, and additionally with the following policies.

• Health and Safety

The Hall Trustees are responsible for providing a facility that complies with all applicable current Health and Safety legislation.

Hall Users are responsible for complying with all notices and instructions provided by the Hall Trustees, and for taking reasonable care to protect themselves and other people from harm.

Hall Users shall observe all relevant food health and hygiene legislation and regulations if preparing, serving or selling food.

• Environment

The Hall Trustees are committed to protecting the environment, and in particular the local environment in and around the Hall.

Hall Users shall ensure that noise and other nuisance to neighbouring dwellings is kept to a minimum by keeping doors and windows closed where reasonably possible, and refraining from noisy behaviour outside the Hall.

Hall Users are requested to conserve energy, and maximise recycling.

• Behaviour





Hall Users can expect to be treated with respect.

Hall Users are requested to ensure that their behaviour at all times does not cause offence to other people.

The Hall Trustees will not tolerate abuse of any kind, especially abuse to Hall Staff. The Hall Trustees will seek to prosecute anyone causing harm, or intending to cause harm, to Hall Staff.
